

WEBSITE PRIVACY POLICY

ARTICLE 1: Preamble

This privacy policy applies to the site: Dream-wines.eu.

The purpose of this privacy policy is to expose users of the site:

- How their personal data are collected and processed. All data capable of identifying a user must be considered as personal data. These include the first and last name, age, postal address, email address, location of the user or his IP address;
- What are the rights of users regarding this data;
- Who is responsible for the processing of personal data collected and processed;
- to whom this data is transmitted;
- Optionally, the site's policy regarding "cookie" files.

ARTICLE 2: GENERAL PRINCIPLES REGARDING THE COLLECTION AND PROCESSING OF DATA

In accordance with the provisions of Article 5 of European Regulation 2016/679, the collection and processing of site user data respects the following principles:

- Lawfulness, loyalty and transparency: data can only be collected and processed with the consent of the user who owns the data. Whenever personal data is collected, the user will be informed that their data is collected, and for what reasons their data is collected;
- Limited purposes: the collection and processing of data is carried out to meet one or more of the objectives determined in these general conditions of use;
- Minimization of data collection and processing: only the data necessary for the proper execution of the objectives pursued by the site are collected;
- Conservation of data reduced in time: data is kept for a limited period of time, of which the user is informed. When this information cannot be communicated, the user is informed of the criteria used to determine the retention period;
- Integrity and confidentiality of data collected and processed: the data controller undertakes to guarantee the integrity and confidentiality of the data collected.

In order to be lawful, and in accordance with the requirements of Article 6 of European Regulation 2016/679, the collection and processing of personal data may only take place if they comply with at least one of the conditions below :

- The user has expressly consented to the processing;
- Processing is necessary for the proper performance of a contract;
- The processing meets a legal obligation;
- The processing is explained by a need linked to the protection of the vital interests of the data subject or of another natural person;
- The processing may be explained by a need linked to the performance of a task of public interest or which falls within the exercise of public authority;
- The processing and collection of personal data is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate and private interests pursued by the controller or by a third party.

ARTICLE 3: PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED AND PROCESSED IN THE CONTEXT OF NAVIGATION ON THE SITE

A. DATA COLLECTED, PROCESSED AND METHOD OF COLLECTION

The personal data collected on the dream-wines.eu site is as follows:

- Full details of the contact or client:
- Name and first name of the contact/customer
- Social reason
- Complete postal address
- Phone number
- E-mail address

This data is collected when the user performs one of the following operations on the site:

- Registration of an online wine order
- Request for contact information from the services of Dream Wines

In addition, when paying on the site, proof of the transaction including the order form and invoice will be kept in the site editor's computer systems.

The data controller will keep all the data collected in his site's computer systems and under reasonable security conditions for a period of: 13 months for a contact or information request or for the duration of the commercial relationship in as part of a wine order from Dream Wines.

The collection and processing of data serve the following purposes:

- Establishment and management of the commercial relationship within the framework of a request for information or order of wines on the website of Dream Wines.

B. TRANSMISSION OF DATA TO THIRD PARTIES

The data may be transmitted to the third party (s) listed below:

- Accounting management body collaborating with Dream Wines in the management of the company.
- Organisation ensuring the security of online bank card transactions.

C. HOSTING OF DATA

The data collected and processed by the site are hosted and processed exclusively in France.

ARTICLE 4: PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR DATA PROCESSING AND DELEGATE FOR DATA PROTECTION

A. THE PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR DATA PROCESSING

The data controller is responsible for determining the purposes and means used for the processing of personal data.

B. OBLIGATIONS OF THE DATA CONTROLLER

The data controller undertakes to protect the personal data collected, not to transmit them to third parties without the user having been informed thereof and to respect the purposes for which these data were collected.

The site has an SSL certificate to guarantee that the information and the transfer of data passing through the site are secure.

An SSL certificate ("Secure Socket Layer" Certificate) is intended to secure the data exchanged between the user and the site.

In addition, the data controller undertakes to notify the user in the event of rectification or deletion of the data, unless this entails disproportionate formalities, costs and procedures for him.

In the event that the integrity, confidentiality or security of the user's personal data is compromised, the data controller undertakes to inform the user by any means.

C. THE DATA PROTECTION OFFICER

In addition, the user is informed that the following person has been appointed Data Protection Officer: Patrick Chirossel.

The role of the Data Protection Officer and to ensure the proper implementation of national and supranational provisions relating to the collection and processing of personal data. He can also be appointed DPO (for Data Protection Officer).

ARTICLE 5: USER'S RIGHTS

In accordance with the regulations concerning the processing of personal data, the user has the rights listed below.

In order for the data controller to grant his request, the user is required to provide him with: his first and last name as well as his e-mail address, and if relevant, his account number or personal space or subscriber.

The data controller is required to respond to the user within a maximum of 30 (thirty) days.

A. PRESENTATION OF USER RIGHTS IN TERMS OF COLLECTION AND PROCESSING OF DATA

Right of access, rectification and right to erasure

The user can read, update, modify or request the deletion of data concerning him, by respecting the procedure set out below:

All customers have a private space in which their consents are stored and can be modified. For any request, the latter must be sent to the Dream Wines services by post to the postal address mentioned at the foot of the website www.dream-wines.eu. The applicant in addition to his application must provide proof of identity (copy of passport or national identity card, see kbis).

If he has one, the user has the right to request the deletion of his personal space by following the following procedure:

Any user with a personal space can report a request for deletion of the latter and the related data by mail to the postal address mentioned at the foot of the website www.dream-wines.eu. The applicant in addition to his application must provide proof of identity (copy of passport or national identity card, see kbis).

Right to data portability

The user has the right to request the portability of his personal data, held by the site, to another site, by complying with the following procedure:

Sending the data portability request to Dream Wines services by post to the postal address mentioned at the foot of the website www.dream-wines.eu. The applicant in addition to his application must provide proof of identity (copy of passport or national identity card, see kbis).

Right to limit and oppose data processing

The user has the right to request the limitation or to oppose the processing of his data by the site, without the site being able to refuse, except to demonstrate the existence of legitimate and compelling reasons, which may prevail over the interests and the rights and freedoms of the user.

In order to request the limitation of the processing of their data or to object to the processing of their data, the user must follow the following procedure:

Sending of the request for limitation of data processing to Dream Wines services by post to the postal address mentioned at the foot of the website www.dream-wines.eu. The applicant in addition to his application must provide proof of identity (copy of passport or national identity card, see kbis).

Right not to be the subject of a decision based exclusively on an automated process

In accordance with the provisions of Regulation 2016/679, the user has the right not to be the subject of a decision based exclusively on an automated process if the decision produces legal effects concerning him, or significantly affects him in a similar way.

Right to determine the fate of data after death

The user is reminded that he can organise what should be the future of his data collected and processed if he dies, in accordance with Law No. 2016-1321 of October 7, 2016.

Right to seize the competent supervisory authority

In the event that the data controller decides not to respond to the user's request, and the user wishes to contest this decision or if he believes that one of the rights listed above, he is entitled to appeal to the CNIL (Commission Nationale de l'Informatique et des Libertés, <https://www.cnil.fr>) or any competent judge.

ARTICLE 6: USE OF "COOKIES" FILES

The site may use the techniques of "cookies".

A "cookie" is a small file (less than 4 kb), stored by the site on the user's hard drive, containing information relating to the user's browsing habits.

These files allow it to process statistics and traffic information, facilitate navigation and improve the service for the convenience of the user.

For the use of "cookie" files involving the saving and analysis of personal data, the user's consent is necessarily requested.

This user consent is considered valid for a maximum period of 13 (thirteen) months. At the end of this period, the site will again request the user's authorization to save "cookie" files on their hard drive.

A. User opposition to the use of "cookie" files by the site

It is brought to the attention of the user that he can oppose the registration of these "cookie" files by configuring his browser software.

In the event that the user decides to deactivate the "cookie" files, he can continue browsing the site. However, any dysfunction of the site caused by this manipulation could not be considered as being due to the editor of the site.

B. Description of the "cookie" files used by the site

The site editor draws the user's attention to the fact that the following cookies are used when browsing:

- PHPSESSID (unique identifier for managing exchanges between Internet user and application server)
- Connexion ID (management of the secure connection in the back office),
- Sidebar height (sidebar height memorisation)
- Consentcootra : monitoring acceptance of the use of trackers and cookies
- ga et –gid : monitoring of browsing history by and for analytics

By browsing the site, the user is informed that third party "cookie" files may be saved.

These are more particularly the following third parties: Social networks used by Dream Wines such as Facebook, Instagram, etc., Google

In addition, the site integrates social network buttons, allowing the user to share their activity on the site. "Cookie" files from these social networks are therefore likely to be stored on the user's computer when using these features.

The user's attention is drawn to the fact that these sites have their own privacy policies and general conditions of use that may differ from the site. The site editor invites users to consult the privacy policies and general conditions of use of these sites.

ARTICLE 7: CONDITIONS FOR MODIFICATION OF THE PRIVACY POLICY

The site editor reserves the right to modify it in order to guarantee its conformity with the law in force.
